






WHAT



RESULTS

- 35 SWIMMING POOLS IN 33 MUNICIPALITES
- OVER 4000 PEOPLE
- OVER 4000 KM
 - Rangárþing ytra (Hella) 375m per inhabitants. = 311,5km.
 - Rangárþing eystra (Hvolsvöllur) per inhabitants. = 260,5km.
 - Hrísey 250,5m per inhabitants. = 43km.
 - Skútustaðarhreppur 189m per inhabitants. = 74.6km.
 - Dalvíkurbyggð 179m per inhabitants. = 245km.
